


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Tea Cup mittens



YARN

1 ball of Rosários 4 Tea Cup yarn, colour 07 (50g/300m).

NEEDLES

3 mm.

NOTIONS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, waste yarn.

GALIGE

 $30 \ \text{sts}$ and $38 \ \text{rows}$ - $10\text{x}10 \ \text{cm}$ in stockinette stitch with $3 \ \text{mm}$ needle.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 41 sts, join to knit in the round and work the garter stitch cuff:

Rnd 1: knit.

Rnd 2: purl.

Repeat rnds 1 - 2, 1 more time.

Work the mitten with the lace detail:

Rnd 1: K1, pm, [chart A], pm, K to end.

Rnd 2: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to end.

Repeat rnd 2, 12 more times, ending on rnd 14 of chart A.

WORK INCREASES FOR THE THUMB

Left hand

Rnd 15: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to 4 sts from end, pm, Kfb, K1, Kfb, pm, K1.

Rnd 16: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to end.

Rnd 17: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to marker, slm, Kfb, K to marker, Kfb, slm, K1.

Rnd 18: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to end.

Repeat rnds 17 - 18, 11 more times, ending with 25 sts in between markers.

Separate thumb:

Rnd 41: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to marker, remove marker, slip 25 sts to waste yarn and leave on hold; remove marker, cast on 2 sts; K1.

Right hand

Rnd 15: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K1, pm, **Kfb**, K1, **Kfb**, pm, K to end.

Rnd 16: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to end.

Rnd 17: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K1, slm, Kfb, K to marker, Kfb, slm, K to end.

Rnd 1: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to end.

Repeat rnds 17 - 18, 11 more times, ending with 25 sts in between markers.

Separate thumb:

Rnd 41: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K1, remove marker, slip 25 sts to waste yarn and leave on hold, remove marker, cast on 2 sts, K to end

Continue the hand

Rnd 42: K1, slm, [chart A], slm, K to end.

Repeat rnd 42, 28 more times, ending in rnd 14 of chart A.

Work garter stitch border:

Rnd 1: knit.

Rnd 2: purl.

Repeat rnds 1 - 2, 1 more time.

Bind off all stitches loosely (if necessary, use a bigger needle).

THUMB

Return hed thumb sts to the needles and Knit all 25 sts + pick up and knit 2 sts over the cast on sts - 27 sts.

Join to work in the the round and Knit 6 rnds.

Work garter stitch border:

Rnd 1: knit.

Rnd 2: purl.

Repeat rnds 1 - 2, 1 more time.

Bind off all stitches loosely (if necessary, use a bigger needle).

CHART

Chart A - written instruction

Rnd 1: P1, (yo, K1) x 3, SSK x 3, P1. [11 sts]

Rnd 2: P1, K9, P1.

Rnd 3: P1, (K1, yo) x 3, SSK x 3, P1.

Rnd 4: P1, K9, P1.

Rnd 5: repeat Rnd 1.

Rnds 6 - 9: repeat Rnds 2 - 5.

Rnds 10 - 13: P1, K9, P1.

Rnd 14: P1, K9, P1.

Rnd 15: P1, K2tog x 3, (K1, yo) x 3, P1.

Rnd 16: P1, K9, P1.

Rnd 17: P1, K2tog x 3, (yo, K1) x 3, P1.

Rnds 18 - 21: repeat Rnds 14 - 17.

Rnd 22: P1, K9, P1.

Rnd 23: repeat Rnd 15.

Rnds 24 - 28: P1, K9, P1.

ABREVIATIONS

K: knit

P: purl

cm: centimeters

st/sts: stitch/stitches

Rnd/rnds: round/rounds

pm: place marker

slm: slip marker

yo: yarn over

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together

SSK: slip, slip, knit (slip a stitch as if to knit, slip a second stitch as if to knit, insert left needle into the front of the slipped stitches

and knit)

Kfb: knit front and back (knit 1 stitch but don't drop it of left hand needle; knit the same stitch again through back loop and drop it off the needle)

TEA CUP

(35% Wool, 30% Acrylic, 35% Viscose)

Tea Cup is a thin, but very snugly yarn. Its delicate texture makes it the perfect choice for knitting lightweight pieces, such as these mittens, where the lace stitches are enhanced owing to the incredible nuances of this yarn.
