# Fadista shawl

## YARN

5 skeins of Rosários 4 Caravela yarn, colour 22 (100g/350m).

## NEEDLES

3 mm circular needles (if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).

## GAUGE

20 sts and 32 rows - 10x10 cm in lace stitch (chart B) with 3 mm needle, washed and blocked (it's important to wash and block your swatch in order to get the correct gauge).

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

64 cm wide and 220 cm long.

## INSTRUCTION

Cast on 124 sts and purl 1 row.

Work **chart A** or following written instruction:

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl3 wyib, P2, (K2tog, yo) x 2, [P1, (yo, ssk) x 2, P1, (K2tog, yo) x 2] x 11, P2, K3.

**Row 2 and all WS rows:** Sl3 wyif, K2, [(P4, K1) x 2] x 11, P4, K2, P3.

**Row 3:** Sl3 wyib, P2, (yo, ssk) x 2, [P1, (K2tog, yo) x 2, P1, (yo, ssk) x 2] x 11, P2, K3.

**Row 5:** repeat row 1.

**Row 7:** repeat row 3.

**Row 9:** repeat row 1.

Work **chart B** or following written instruction:

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl3 wyib, p1, k1, yo, ssk, [yo, ssk, k1, (k2tog, yo) x 2, k1, yo, ssk] x 11, yo, ssk, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 2 and all WS rows:** Sl3 wyif, K1, P116, K1, P3.

**Row 3:** Sl3 wyib, p1, k2, yo, [ssk, yo, sskpo, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo] x 11, ssk, yo, ssk, p1, k3.

**Row 5:** Sl3 wyib, p1, k1, k2tog, yo, [k2tog, yo, k1, (yo, ssk) x 2, k1, k2tog, yo] x 11, k2tog, yo, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 7:** Sl3 wyib, P1, K2tog, yo, K2tog, (yo, K3, yo, ssk, yo, sskpo, yo, K2tog) x 11, yo, K2, P1, K3.

Continue working, repeating the 8 rows of chart B, until you complete 26 repeats of the chart (208 rows).

Work **chart C** or following written instruction:

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl3 wyib, p1, k1, yo, ssk, [yo, ssk, k1, (k2tog, yo) x 2, k1, yo, ssk] x 11, yo, ssk, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 2 and all WS rows:** Sl3 wyif, K1, P116, K1, P3.

**Row 3:** repeat row 1.

**Row 5:** Sl3 wyib, p1, k2, yo, [ssk, yo, sskpo, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo] x 11, ssk, yo, ssk, p1, k3.

**Row 7:** Sl3 wyib, p1, k1, k2tog, yo, [k2tog, yo, k1, (yo, ssk) x 2, k1, k2tog, yo] x 11, k2tog, yo, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 9:** repeat row 7.

**Row 11:** Sl3 wyib, P1, K2tog, yo, K2tog, (yo, K3, yo, ssk, yo, sskpo, yo, K2tog) x 11, yo, K2, P1, K3.

Continue working, repeating the 12 rows of chart C, until you complete complete 18 repeats of the chart (216 rows).

Work **chart B** or following written instruction:

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl3 wyib, p1, k1, yo, ssk, [yo, ssk, k1, (k2tog, yo) x 2, k1, yo, ssk] x 11, yo, ssk, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 2 and all WS rows:** Sl3 wyif, K1, P116, K1, P3.

**Row 3:** Sl3 wyib, p1, k2, yo, [ssk, yo, sskpo, yo, k2tog, yo, k3, yo] x 11, ssk, yo, ssk, p1, k3.

**Row 5:** Sl3 wyib, p1, k1, k2tog, yo, [k2tog, yo, k1, (yo, ssk) x 2, k1, k2tog, yo] x 11, k2tog, yo, k1, p1, k3.

**Row 7:** Sl3 wyib, P1, K2tog, yo, K2tog, (yo, K3, yo, ssk, yo, sskpo, yo, K2tog) x 11, yo, K2, P1, K3.

Continue working, repeating the 8 rows of chart B, until you complete 26 repeats of the chart (208 rows).

Work **chart A** or following written instruction:

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl3 wyib, P2, (K2tog, yo) x 2, (P1, (yo, ssk) x 2, P1, (K2tog, yo) x 2) 11 times, P2, K3.

**Row 2 and all WS rows:** Sl3 wyif, K2, [(P4, K1) x 2] x 11, P4, K2, P3.

**Row 3:** Sl3 wyib, P2, (yo, ssk) x 2, [P1, (K2tog, yo) x 2, P1, (yo, ssk) x 2] x 11, P2, K3.

**Row 5:** repeat row 1.

**Row 7:** repeat row 3.

**Row 9:** repeat row 1.

Bind off all sts in ribbing pattern.

## FRINGES

Cut several pieces of yarn with 40 cm long. For each fringe: join two pieces of yarn and fold them in half; insert the crochet hook into the border stitch and hook the folded yarn loop; pull the loop through the shawl border and push the ends of the yarn through this loop; pull it tight to form the fringe. Continue adding fringes every 1,5 cm until the end of the border. Once you have finished, lay the fringe flat and trim the ends all the same length with the scissors. Repeat in the other end of the shawl.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**K:** knit

**P:** purl

**cm:** centimeters

**st/sts:** stitch/stitches

**RS:** right side

**WS:** wrong side

**Sl3 wyib:** slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn in back

**Sl3 wyif:** slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn in front

**yo:** yarn over

**K2tog:** knit 2 stitches together

**ssk:** slip, slip, knit (slip a stitch as if to knit, slip a second stitch as if to knit, insert left needle into the front of the slipped stitches and knit)

**sskpo:** double decrease (work a ssk, then place the stitch back on the left hand needle; pass the second stitch on the left needle over the ssk stitch, then return the stitch to the right hand needle)

## CARAVELA

(100% Bamboo Viscose)

It is already a tradition: for St. Anthony's Day, Filipa Carneiro has designed a new shawl using Rosários 4 yarn. This year, the shawl is made with Caravela, an incredibly, soft yarn where the lacy stitch blends perfectly.
