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## GAUGE

21 sts and 32 rows $-10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in stockinette stitch pattern and with 3 mm needles, washed and blocked (it's important to wash and block your swatch in order to get the correct gauge).

## YARN

1 skein of Madragoa from Rosários 4, in colour 25 (100\% silk, $50 \mathrm{~g} / 200 \mathrm{~m}$ ) - colour A
2 skeins of Madragoa from Rosários 4, in colour 21 (100\% silk, 50g/200m) - colour B
2 skeins of Madragoa from Rosários 4, in colour 23 (100\% silk, 50g/200m) - colour C

## NEEDLES

$3,0 \mathrm{~mm}$ circular needles (if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).

## NOTIONS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, waste yarn.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

230 cm long and 46 cm wide in the centre.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Garter tab cast-on:
With waste yarn cast-on 2 sts. Change to colour $\mathbf{A}$ and purl 16 rows.
Row 1, colour A (WS): P2, pm, turn the work 90 degrees and pick-up and purl 8 sts along the side of the garter tab, pm, unravel the provisional cast-on and P2-12 sts on the needle.
Work in stockinette st with garter st stripes:
Row 2, colour A (RS): P2, slm, yo, $K$ to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 3, colour A: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 4, colour A: P2, slm, yo, $\mathbf{K}$ to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Join colour C:
Row 5, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 6, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Repeat rows 3-6, 6 more times. [70 sts]
Work in garter st:
Row 1, colour A (WS): P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour A: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 3, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 4, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Join colour B and cut colour A yarn:
Row 5, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 6, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 7, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.

Row 8, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2. [86 sts] Work in stockinette st with garter st stripes:
Row 9, colour B (WS): P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 10, colour B: P2, slm, yo, $\mathbf{K}$ to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 11, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 12, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Repeat rows 9 - 12, 4 more times. [126 sts]
Work first lace stripe:
Row 1, colour B (WS): P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour B: P2, slm, yo, [chart A], yo, slm, P2.
Continue working in pattern established by row 2 until you complete the 6 rows of chart A. [138 sts]
Work in garter st:
Row 1, colour C (WS): P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 3, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 4, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 5, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 6, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Join colour A and cut colour B yarn:
Row 7, colour A: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 8, colour A: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 9, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 10, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2. [158 sts] Work second lace stripe:
Row 1, colour A (WS): P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour A: P2, slm, yo, [chart B], yo, slm, P2.
Continue working in pattern established by row 2 until you complete all the 24 rows of chart B. [206 sts]
Work in stockinette st with garter st stripes:
Row 1, colour C (WS): P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 3, colour A: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 4, colour A: P2, slm, yo, $\mathbf{K}$ to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Repeat rows 1-4, 2 more times. [230 sts]
Work in garter st:
Row 1, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 3, colour A: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 4, colour A: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 5, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 6, cotlour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2. Join colour B and cut colour A yarn:

Row 7, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 8, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 9, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 10, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2. [250 sts] Work third lace stripe:
Row 1, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour B: P2, slm, yo, [chart C], yo, slm, P2.
Continue working in pattern established by row 2 until you complete all the 24 rows of chart C. [298 sts]

Work in stockinette st with garter st stripes:
Row 1, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 3, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 4, colour B: P2, slm, yo, $K$ to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Repeat rows 1-4, 2 more times. [322 sts]
Work in garter st:
Row 1, colour C: P2, slm, yo, $P$ to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 3, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 4, colour B: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 5, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 6, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2. [334 sts]
Work the last lace stripe:
Row 1, colour C: P2, slm, yo, P to marker, yo, slm, P2.
Row 2, colour C: P2, slm, yo, [chart D], yo, slm, P2.
Continue working in pattern established by row 2 until you complete all 38 rows of chart D. [406 sts]
Bind-off all sts purlwise and loosely (if necessary, use a bigger needle).

## FINISHING

Weave in all ends with tapestry needle. Wash carefully with a mild soap. Wet block, opening the lace stripes and adjusting the shawl to the final measurements.

## ABBREVIATIONS

K: knit
P: purl
cm: centimeters
st/sts: stitch/stitches
RS: right side
WS: wrong side
pm: place marker
slm: slip marker
yo: yarn over
k2tog: knit 2 together
ssk: slip, slip, knit (slip a stitch as if to knit, slip a second stitch as if to knit, insert left needle into the front of the slipped stitches and knit)
CDD: centered double decrease (slip 2 stitches together as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, with left hand needle pass slipped stitches over)
