This pattern is a partnership between Marta (Pelo d'Arame) and André (Loft das Mantas). It's a unisex t-shirt with the colours of the rainbow. You can choose between two versions: one in more vibrant tones and the other in more pastel tones. The name Ary, intends to honor the author and singer Ary dos Santos, one of the first LGBT activists in Portugal. He wrote several lyrics that Amália Rodrigues interpreted. Being two relevant personalities in this community, we chose this name for our piece, leaving the door open for new inspirations.

YARN FOR THE VIBRANT TONES VERSION:

- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 13 - colour A.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 21 - colour B.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 23 - colour C.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 25 - colour D.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 27 - colour E.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 29 - colour F.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 31 - colour G.**

PASTEL TONES VERSION:

- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 13 - colour A.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 01 - colour B.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 03 - colour C.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 05 - colour D.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 07 - colour E.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 09 - colour F.**
- 1 ball of **FALÉSIA** from Rosários 4, **colour 11 - colour G.**

GAUGE

24 sts and 40 rows – 10x10 cm in stockinette stitch with 3 mm needle, washed and blocked (it's important to wash and block your swatch in order to get the correct gauge).

NEEDLES

2,5 and 3 mm circular needles (if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).

NOTIONS

5 stitch markers (1 different from the others), tapestry needle, waste yarn.

SIZES

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

92,5 cm final bust measurements.

COLOUR SCHEME FOR THE STRIPES:

- colour B** = work 30 rnds.
- colour A** = work 2 rnds.
- colour C** = work 30 rnds.
- colour A** = work 2 rnds.
- colour D** = work 30 rnds.
- colour A** = work 2 rnds.
- colour E** = work 30 rnds.
- colour A** = work 2 rnds.
- colour F** = work 30 rnds.
- colour A** = work 2 rnds.
- colour G** = work 30 rnds.

INSTRUCTIONS

NECKLINE

With colour 13 and smaller needle cast on 100 sts. Join to work in the round and place BOR. Work in 2x2 ribbing: (k2, p2) rep to end. Repeat until you complete 12 rnds in ribbing.

RAGLAN

Change to bigger needles and colour B. Knit 1 rnd and place markers as follows: k20, pm, k10, pm, k40, pm, k10, pm, p20.

Work the raglan increases and shape the neck with short rows:

Row 1: k19, **M1R**, k1, slm, k1, **M1L**, k9, **M1R**, k1, slm, k1, **M1L**, k4, turn.

Row 2: DS, p to BOR, slBOR, p20, slm, p10, slm, p4, turn.

Row 3: DS, k to BOR (increasing 1 st before and after every marker) k to DS, k4, turn.

Row 4: DS, p to BOR (don't increase on WS), p até à MD, 4p, turn.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until back measures 5 cm from the beginning. End in a WS row.

Return to work in circular and work 29 rnds in colour B increasing as follows:

Rnd 1: (K to marker, M1R, k1, M1L) rep to end.

Rnd 2: K to end.

Repeat rnds 1 and 2 until you have this the following st count: 50 sts, 70 sts, 100 sts, 70 sts, 50 sts. Be sure to continue changing colours as stated in the colour scheme.

BODY

Knit 50 sts, place next 70 sts to waste yarn and backwards loop cast on 12 sts; knit 100 sts, place next 70 sts to waste yarn and backwards loop cast on 12 sts, knit 50 sts. [224 sts]

Continue working the 224 sts in the round and in stockinette stitch (knit every rnd) and changing colours as stated in the colour scheme.

Change to smaller needle and colour A and knit 1 rnd. Work in 2x2 ribbing: (k2, p2) rep every rnd until you complete 12 rnds in ribbing. Bind off all sts in ribbing pattern.

SLEEVES

Place on the bigger needle the 70 sts on hold for the sleeve on the needles. Start in the center of the cast-on sts in the armhole and pick up and knit 6 sts. Knit the 70 sts on the needles, pick up and knit 6 sts. Place BOR and knit 10 rnds.

Change to smaller needle and colour A and knit 1 rnd. Work in 2x2 ribbing: (k2, p2) rep every rnd until you complete 12 rnds of ribbing. Bind off all sts in ribbing pattern.

Weave in all ends with a tapestry needle. Wash carefully with mild soap. Block garment to final measurements.



ABBREVIATIONS**K:** knit**P:** purl**cm:** centimeters**Rep:** repeat**RS:** right side**WS:** wrong side**st/sts:** stitch/stitches**pm:** place marker**slm:** slip marker**BOR:** beginning of round marker**sIBOR:** slip beginning of round marker

M1L: make one left (insert the left-hand needle, from front to back, under the strand of yarn which runs between the stitch just worked and the next stitch on the left-hand needle. Knit this st through the back loop)

M1R: make one right (insert the left-hand needle, from back to front, under the strand of yarn which runs between the stitch just worked and the next stitch on the left-hand needle. Knit this st through the front loop)

German short-rows**DS:** double stitch

On right side rows: knit to turning point; turn and slip the first stitch purl-wise with yarn in front, bring yarn over the needle to the back of work and pull tight - this creates the double stitch (DS). Bring yarn between needles to front of work to begin purling.

On wrong side rows: purl to turning point; turn and bring yarn to front between needles, slip the first stitch purl wise; bring yarn over the needle to the back of work and pull tight - this creates the double stitch (DS); begin knitting.

On following rows/rounds work DS's as single stitches, knitting or purling both legs of the DS together.
