## YARN

- 1 ball of **Merino Land** from Rosários 4 **color 25** (50g/220m; 100% merino wool) **COLOR A**.
- 4 balls of **Merian** from Rosários 4 **color 29** (50g/220m; 100% merino wool) **COLOR B**.

#### **NEEDLES**

3,5 mm crochet hook.

## **NOTIONS**

Stitch markers, scissors, measure tape and tapestry needle.

Mat and blocking needles.

## **GAUGE**

A square of  $10 \times 10$  cm is 19 double crochet and 10 rows. This sample is worked with a 3,5 mm crochet hook, in double crochet and has not been blocked.

## **MEASUREMENTS**

 $170\,\mathrm{cm}$  long and  $40\,\mathrm{cm}$  wide, washed and blocked.





#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

Chain 90 with color A.

R1: chain 3. 90 dc. (chain 3 count as 1 dc). Turn.

R2: chain 3. 90 dc BLO. Turn.

From row 3 to 20, you will work on the motif called "Leafy". You can see the chart below.

**R 4:** chain 3.1 dc, chain 5, sk 5, 1 sc, chain 5, sk 5. \*3 dc, ch 5, sk 5, 1 sc, ch 5, sk 5\*. Rep from \* to \*7 times. 1 sc, 2 dc. Turn.

**R 5:** ch 2.1 dc s sp. Ch 5, sk 5, 1 dc. Ch 5, sk 5, dc3toq. \*ch 5, sk 5, 1 dc. Ch 5, sk 5, dc3toq\*. Rep from \*to \* 7 times. Ch 5, sk 5, 1 dc, ch 5, sk 5, dc2tog. Turn.

**R 6:** ch 1, 1 sc s p. Ch 5, sk 5, 3 dc s sp, ch 5, sk 5. \* 1 sc, 3 dc s sp, ch 5, sk 5, 1 sc\*. Rep from \*to \* 7 times. Ch 5, sk 5 5, 3 dc s sp, ch 5, sk 5, 1 sc. Turn.

**R 7:** ch 1, 1 sc s sp. Ch 5, sk 5, 3 dc, ch 5, sk 5. \*1 sc, ch 5, sk 5, 3 dc, ch 5, sk 5, 1 sc\*. Rep from \* to \* 7 times. Ch 5, sk 5, 3 dc, ch 5, sk 5, 1 sc. Turn.

R 8: ch 8, sk 5, dc3tog, ch 5, sk 5. \*1 dc, ch 5, sk 5, dc3tog, ch 5, sk 5, 1 dc\*. Rep from \* to \* 7 times. Ch 5, sk 5, dc3tog, ch 5, sk 5, 1 dc. Turn.

**R 9:** ch 3.1 dc s sp, ch 5, sk 5, 1 sc. Ch 5, sk 5, 3 dc s sp. \*ch 5, sk 5, 1 sc, ch 5, sk 5, 3 dc s sp\*. Rep from \* to \* 7 times. Ch 5, sk 5, 1 sc. Ch 5, sk 5, 2 dc s sp. Turn.

Rows 10 to 14: repeat rows from 4 to 8. Turn at the end of every row.

Rows 15 to 20: repeat rows from 9 to 14. Turn at the end of every row.

R 21: chain 2. \*4 dc in the 5 chain space, 1 dc over dc3tog. 4 dc in the 5 ch space, 1 dc over dc.\* Repeat from \* to \* 9 times. You'll have 91 stitches. Turn.

#### CHANGE TO COLOR B.

Rows 22 to 125: chain 2 cad. 90 DC BLO. Turn at the end of every row.

#### CHANGE TO COLOR A.

**R 126:** chain 2 cad. 90 DC BLO. Turn.

Rows 127 to 145: repeat rows from 3 to 20. Turn at the end of every row.

**R 146:** repeat R 21. Turn.

**R 147:** chain 2. 90 DC BLO. Turn.


Fasten off

## **BLOCKING**

It's necessary to block this shawl to have a better definition of the stitches. To do that, place the shawl over a foam mat, and use blocking needles to give the correct form. Wet the shawl with water and yarn soap. Leave it till dry.





1DCSSP: 1 double crochet worked in the same


