



# AMORA

#AMORASHRUG | #TJOUTONO2023

Para:

*Rosários4*<sup>®</sup>

**YARN:** 2 balls of **TERRA** from Rosários4, color 14 (100% merino wool; 100g/ 170m) - **color A.**

3 balls of **TERRA TWEED** from Rosários4, color 11 (97% merino wool; 3%viscose; 10g/ 170m) - **color B.**

**GAUGE:** 18 sts and 26 rows - 10x10 cm in irish moss stitch with 5 mm needle (é importante lavar e secar a amostra pois a contagem de malhas pode alterar com a primeira lavagem).

**NEEDLES:** 5 mm circular needles with 80 cm cable (if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).

**NOTIONS:** tapestry needle, removable stitch markers, waste yarn.

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:** 130 cm wide and 60 cm height in the back.

## PART 3

### LEFT FRONT

With RS facing and color B pick up and knit 72 sts along the selvage, from the collar cast-on to the beginning of the back (pick up approx. 2 sts every 3 rows). Work the set up row (WS): sl3wyif, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, k1, p2.

Join color A and, from here, work in stripes, alternating colors every 2 rows. Work in irish moss stitch pattern and decreases as follows:

**Row 1, color A (RS):** k1, **ssk**, (p1, k1), rep to 3 sts from end, k3. [1st dec]

**Row 2, color A (WS):** sl3wyif, (p1, k1) rep até 2 sts do final, p2.

**Row 3, color B:** k1, **ssk**, p1, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, k3. [1st dec]

**Row 4, color B:** sl3wyif, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, k1, p2.

Repeat rows 1 to 4, 3 more times. Then work rows 1 and 2 once. [63 sts]

Cut color A and continue working with color B only:

**Row 1 (RS):** k1, **ssk**, p1, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, k3. [1st dec]

**Row 2 (WS):** sl3wyif, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, k1, p2.

**Row 3:** k1, **ssk**, (p1, k1), rep to 3 sts from end, k3. [1st dec]

**Row 4:** sl3wyif, (p1, k1) rep até 2 sts do final, p2.

Repeat rows 1 to 4, 9 more times. Completing a total of 29 decrease rows from the beginning. [43 sts]

Leave all sts on hold.

### RIGHT FRONT

With RS facing and color B pick up and knit 72 sts along the selvage, from the back to the end of the collar (pick up approx. 2 sts every 3 rows). Work the set up row (WS): p2, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, sl3wyif.

Join color A and, from here, work in stripes, alternating colors every 2 rows. Work in irish moss stitch pattern and decreases as follows:

**Row 1, color A (RS):** k3, (k1, p1), rep to 3 sts from end, **k2tog**, k1. [1st dec]

**Row 2, color A (WS):** p2, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, sl3wyif.

**Row 3, color B:** k3, (p1, k1) rep to 4 sts from end, p1, **k2tog**, k1. [1st dec]

**Row 4, color B:** p2, (k1, p1) rep to 4 sts from end, k1, sl3wyif.

Repeat rows 1 to 4, 3 more times. Then work rows 1 and 2 once. [63 sts]

Cut color A and continue working with color B only:

**Row 1 (RS):** k3, (p1, k1) rep to 4 sts from end, p1, **k2tog**, k1. [1st dec]

**Row 2 (WS):** p2, (k1, p1) rep to 4 sts from end, k1, sl3wyif.

**Row 3:** k3, (k1, p1), rep to 3 sts from end, **k2tog**, k1. [1st dec]

**Row 4:** p2, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, sl3wyif.

Repeat rows 1 to 4, 9 more times. Completing a total of 29 decrease rows from the beginning. [43 sts]  
Leave all sts on hold.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together.

**ssk:** slip, slip, knit (slip a stitch as if to knit, slip a second stitch as if to knit, insert the left-hand needle into the front of the slipped stitches, and knit)
