



YARN: 1 ball of **ARRAIOLOS** from Rosários4 color 637 (100% wool; 50g/51m).

NEEDLES: 4.5 mm needles.

GAUGE: 15 sts = 10 cm in garter stitch with 4.5 mm needle (gauge is not important in this pattern, but it affects the final size of the potholder).

NOTIONS: tapestry needle.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS: 21 cm wide in the base and 20 cm height.

ABBREVIATIONS

k: knit.

p: purl.

RS: right side.

WS: wrong side.

st/sts: stitch/ stitches.

sl1 wyif: slip 1 st knitwise and with the yarn in front of the work.

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together.

dec: decrease.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 35 sts.

Row 1 (RS): p to end.

Row 2 (WS): sl1 wyif, p to end.

Row 3: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [dec 1 st]

Row 4: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [dec 1 st]

Repeat rows 3 and 4, 6 more times. [21 sts]

Row 17: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [20 sts]

Row 18: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end, cast on 3 sts. [22 sts]

Row 19: p to end, cast on 3 sts. [25 sts]

Row 20: p to end.

Row 21: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [dec 1 st]

Row 22: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [dec 1 st]

Repeat rows 21 and 22, 4 more times. [15 sts]

Row 31: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [14 sts]

Row 32: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end, cast on 3 sts. [16 sts]

Row 33: p to end, cast on 3 sts. [19 sts]

Row 34: p to end.

Row 35: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [dec 1 st]

Row 36: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [dec 1 st]

Repeat rows 35 and 36, 4 more times. [9 sts]

Row 45: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [8 sts]

Row 46: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end, cast on 3 sts. [10 sts]

Row 47: p to end, cast on 3 sts. [13 sts]

Row 48: p to end.

Row 49: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [dec 1 st]

Row 50: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [dec 1 st]

Repeat rows 49 and 50, 3 more times. [5 sts]

Row 57: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [4 sts]

Row 58: sl1 wyif, p2tog, p to end. [3 sts]

Row 59: sl1 wyif, p2tog. [2 sts]

Do not turn the work and knit and i-cord as follows: (place the 2 sts back to the left-hand needle, knit 2) repeat until the i-cord measures approx. 8 cm. Do not bind off. Cut the yarn leaving an approximately 20 cm tail. With the tapestry needle pass the tail through the 2 sts, removing them from the knitting needle and pulling to close. Sew to form a loop and weave in the tail.
