



# Colete Caramelo

**YARN:** 10 (12, 15) balls of **BIO WOOL** from Rosários4, color 09 (100% organic wool; 50g/82m).

**GAUGE:** 17 sts and 26 rows - 10x10 cm in stockinette stitch with 4.5 mm needle, washed and blocked (it's important to wash and block your swatch in order to get the correct gauge).

**NEEDLES:** 4 mm and 4.5 mm circular needles with 80 cm cable (if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).

**NOTIONS:** tapestry needle, stitch markers, waste yarn.

**SIZES:** 1 (2, 3).

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:** 104 (122, 141) cm final bust measurements, 20 (22, 25) cm of armhole depth and 24 (26, 28) cm long (from armhole to bind-off).

## PART 4

### BODY

JOIN FOR THE BODY: work the 86 (102, 118) sts in the front in established pattern, place the 86 (102, 118) sts on hold from the back on the left-hand needle and knit. There are 172 (204, 236) sts on the needles. Join to work in the round and place BOR.

Work the body in stockinette stitch and with the cables pattern on the front: k to marker, slm, [chart A], slm, k to end.

Continue working in established pattern until the body measures 20 (22, 24) cm from the armhole (or 6 cm less than desired length). Adjust if necessary to end at rnd 8 or 16 of chart A. Change to the smaller needle and work in 2x2 rib as follows: (k2, p2) rep to 2 sts before marker, k2, slm, (p2, k2) rep to 2 sts before marker, p2, slm, (k2, p2) rep to end. Repeat this rnd until you complete 14 rnds of rib. Bind off in ribbing pattern.
