## YARN

7 (10, 13) skeins of **Alfama** from Rosários 4, **color 45**.

## GAUGE

20 sts and 10 rows – 10 x 10 cm in double crochet stitch with 4 mm needles, washed and blocked (it's important to wash and block your swatch in order to get the correct gauge).

## NEEDLES

4 mm crochet hook.

## NOTIONS

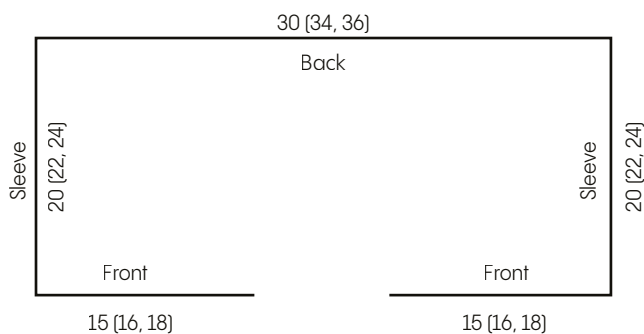
Tapestry needle, stitch markers (for the increases) and scissors.

Before you start:

- This cardigan is made using the Top Down technique.
- This pattern is available in 3 sizes: S, M and L. They're represented as "S (M, L)" on the instructions.
- There is a chart with the measurements of each size.
- Chains at the beginning of each round count as 1 double crochet.
- The increases will be made with 1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc, where the marker is placed.

## CHART

Distribution of the stitches:



Measurements (centimetres):

Long: 53 cm (all sizes)	S	M	L

## PATTERN

Chain 99 [109, 119].

**Row 1:** Ch 2 (= 1 dc), 14 [15, 17] dc, ch 1 and place the marker, 20 [22, 24] dc, ch 1 and place the marker, 30 [34, 36] dc, ch 1 and place the marker, 20 [22, 24] dc, ch 1 and place the marker, 15 [16, 18] dc, turn. [100 [110, 120] sts]

**Row 2:** Ch 2, 14 [15, 17] dc, INC where the marker is placed, 20 [22, 24] dc, INC where the marker is placed, 30 [34, 36] dc, INC where the marker is placed, 20 [22, 24] dc, INC where the marker is placed, 15 [16, 18] dc, turn. [108 [118, 128] sts]

**Row 3:** Ch 2, 15 [16, 18] dc, INC, 22 [24, 26] dc, INC, 32 [36, 38] dc, INC, 22 [24, 26] dc, INC, 16 [17, 19] dc, turn. [116 [126, 136] sts]

**Row 4:** Ch 2, 16 [17, 19] dc, INC, 24 [26, 28] dc, INC, 34 [38, 40] dc, INC, 24 [26, 28] dc, INC, 17 [18, 20] dc, turn. [124 [134, 144] sts]

**Row 5:** Ch 2, 17 [18, 20] dc, INC, 26 [28, 30] dc, INC, 36 [40, 42] dc, INC, 26 [28, 30] dc, INC, 18 [19, 21] dc, turn. [132 [142, 152] sts]

**Row 6:** Ch 2, 18 [19, 21] dc, INC, 28 [30, 32] dc, INC, 38 [42, 44] dc, INC, 28 [30, 32] dc, INC, 19 [20, 22] dc, turn. [140 [150, 160] sts]

**Row 7:** Ch 2, 19 [20, 22] dc, INC, 30 [32, 34] dc, INC, 40 [44, 46] dc, INC, 30 [32, 34] dc, INC, 20 [21, 23] dc, turn. [148 [158, 168] sts]

**Row 8:** Ch 2, 20 [21, 23] dc, INC, 32 [34, 36] dc, INC, 42 [46, 48] dc, INC, 32 [34, 36] dc, INC, 21 [22, 24] dc, turn. [156 [166, 176] sts]

**Rows 9 to 22 (24, 26):** repeat row 8. Make 1 dc in every available stitch and make an increase over the marker. On the chart below you can see the stitches of every section and the stitches at the end of each row.

Now you have finished the yoke of the cardigan. It's time to join the front and back and start to crochet the body.

**Row 23 (25, 27):** Ch 2, 35 [38, 42] dc from the first front, join both sides from the sleeve introducing the hook through the chain of both sides of the last increase and make 1 dc, 72 [80, 86] dc from the back, join both sides from the other sleeve introducing the hook through the chain of the last increase and make a 1 dc, 36 [39, 43] dc from the other front, turn. You'll have 146 [160, 174] dc.

**Row 24 (26, 28):** Ch 4, sk1, 1"V" st in the next stitch. \*Sk1, 1"V" st in the next stitch\*, repeat from \* to \* 69 [75, 83] times, sk 1, 1 dc, turn. [71 [78, 85] "V" sts]

**Row 25 (27, 29):** Ch 4, 1"V" st over the "V" st from the last row, \*1"V" st over the next "V" st\*, repeat from \* to \* 69 [75, 83] times, sk1, 1 dc over the 3rd chain, turn. [71 [78, 85] "V" sts]

**Rows 26 (28, 30) to 43:** Repeat row 25 [27, 29]. Turn at the end of every row.

## BORDER (ALL SIZES)

You will start at the bottom of the cardigan.

**Row 44:** Ch 2, \* 1 dc over the ch space. 1 dc between every dc\*, repeat from \* to \* until the end of the row.

On the corner, make [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in the same space and continue working on the side, 2 dc on every row.

When you arrive at the neckline, make [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] on the corner, next, 1 dc in every stitch. At the end of the neckline, make [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] on the corner.

Continue working on the other side and make 2 dc for every row.

At the end, make [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] and close with 1 slst.

**Row 45:** continue working on the bottom of the cardigan. Make \* 1 slst, 1 ss, 3 dc-shell, 3 dc-shell on the next stitch \*, repeat from \* to \* along the entire border of the cardigan.

## SLEEVES

Join the yarn in the armhole and repeat row 45 around the entire sleeve opening. Repeat on the other sleeve.

**INC** increase, work (1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) in the same space.

**sk1** skip 1 stitch

**1"V"st** "V" stitch, work (1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) in the same space.

**3 dc-shell** shell made with 3 double crochet worked in the same space.

**[...]** stitches between brackets are made at the same space.

**st(s)** stitch/stitches

**Repeat from \* to \*** Repeat from \* to \*: Repeat the instructions between the asterisks.
