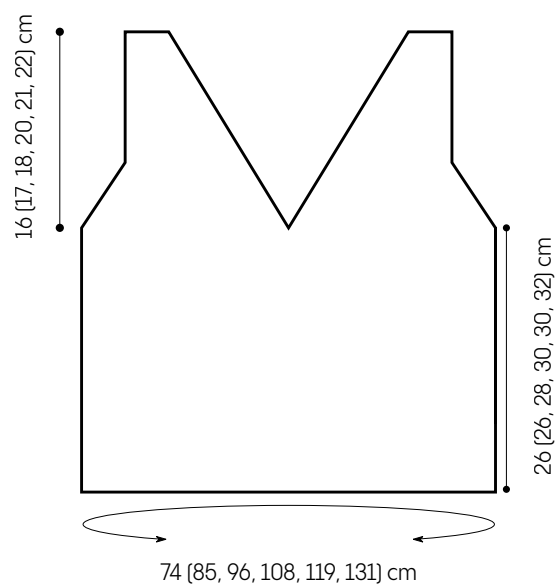

YARN

2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 4) balls of **BEIJA-FLOR** from Rosários 4, **color 04**.

GAUGE

28 sts and 40 rows – 10 x 10 cm in embroidery stitch pattern with 3 mm needles, knitted in the round, washed and blocked (it's important to wash and block your swatch in order to get the correct gauge).

NEEDLES

3 mm circular needles with 80 cm cable (if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).

NOTIONS

Tapestry needle, stitch markers, locking stitch markers, waste yarn.

SIZES

1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

74 (85, 96, 108, 119, 131) cm final bust measurements (refer to the schematic for more measurements); measures with approx. 2 cm of positive ease included.

This top is knitted from the bottom up, in the round and seamlessly. We begin by knitting the bottom hem in garter stitch and then the body in embroidery stitch with 2 faux seams to accentuate the silhouette. At the armhole we separate the work and work each part separately up to the shoulder. We knit back and forth with a yarn over selvedge in the armhole and neckline for a perfect finish. At the end, the shoulders are joined with a 3-needle bind-off and our top is ready.



EMBROIDERY STITCH

Worked flat (back and forth) and for a multiple of 8+4 sts:

Rnd 1: (k4, k2tog, ssk) rep to 4 sts from end, k4.

Rnd 2: k to end.

Rnd 3: (k4, Flower) rep to 4 sts from end, k4.

Rnd 4: k to end.

Rnd 5: (k2tog, ssk, k4) rep to 4 sts from end, k2tog, ssk.

Rnd 6: k to end.

Rnd 7: (Flower, k4) rep to 4 sts from end, Flower.

Rnd 8: k to end.

Repeat rounds 1 to 8. To work this stitch flat, follow the same instructions, but on the even rounds (WS) purl all sts.

Flower: insert the right needle into the space between the decreases (k2tog and ssk) worked previously and pull through one loop, leave the loop on the right-hand needle and knit 2 sts, pull through a second loop in the same way and in the same stitch. Leave the loops loose so they don't pull the fabric.

BODY

Long tail cast on 206 (238, 270, 302, 334, 366) sts. Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist the sts and place BOR. Work the hem in garter stitch:

Rnd 1: k to end.

Rnd 2: p to end.

Repeat rnds 1 and 2, 1 more time.

Work the body in embroidery stitch pattern:

Rnd 1: k1, (k4, k2tog, ssk) x 12 (14, 16, 18, 20, 22), k5, **pm**, p1, **pm**, k1, (k4, k2tog, ssk) x 12 (14, 16, 18, 20, 22), k5, **pm**, p1.

Rnd 2: k to marker, slm, sl1 wyif, slm, k to marker, slm, sl1 wyif.

Rnd 3: k1, (k4, Flower) rep to 5 sts before marker, 5M, slm, p1, slm, k1, (k4, Flower) rep to 5 sts before marker, 5M, slm, p1.

Rnd 4: k to marker, slm, sl1 wyif, slm, k to marker, slm, sl1 wyif.

Rnd 5: k1, (k2tog, ssk, k4) rep to 5 sts before marker, k2tog, ssk, k1, slm, p1, slm, k1, (k2tog, ssk, k4) rep to 5 sts before marker, k2tog, ssk, k1, slm, p1.

Rnd 6: k to marker, slm, sl1 wyif, slm, k to marker, slm, sl1 wyif.

Row 7: k1, (Flower, k4) rep to 5 sts before marker, Flower, k1, slm, p1, slm, k1, (Flower, k4) rep to 5 sts before marker, Flower, k1, slm, p1.

Rnd 8: k to marker, slm, sl1 wyif, slm, k to marker, slm, sl1 wyif.

Continue working in established pattern until the body measures 26 (26, 28, 30, 30, 32) cm from the beginning. Adjust, if necessary, so that you end up in Rnds 3 or 7 of the embroidery stitch.

SEPARATE FRONT AND BACK: work in the established pattern to the marker, remove the marker, bind off 1 st, work in the established pattern to the marker, remove the marker, bind off 1 st; 1 st remains on right-hand needle and continue as follows: ssk, yarn over, knit 45 (53, 61, 69, 77, 85) sts in embroidery stitch (as established), yarn over, k2tog, k1; slip next 51 (59, 67, 75, 83, 91) sts to waste yarn and leave on hold for right front. Slip the next 102 (118, 134, 150, 166, 182) sts to a waste yarn and leave on hold for the back. From now on we'll only work the left front flat, back and forth.

Note: You should continue working in the established pattern, working the embroidery stitch. When working the decreases that form part of the stitch pattern (Rnds 1 or 5), only work the decreases if you have enough stitches to work the full Flower, otherwise work the remaining stitches in stockinette stitch. Embroidery stitch pattern decreases are not included in the stitch count.

LEFT FRONT

Work the armhole and neckline decreases on every row:

Row 2 (WS): sl2 wyif, p to 4 sts from end, **ssp**, sl2 wyif. [dec 1 st]

Row 3 (RS): k1, ssk, yo, **ssk**, work in embroidery stitch to 5 sts from end, k2tog, yo, **k2tog**, k1. [dec 2 sts]

Row 4: sl2 wyif, p to 4 sts from end, **ssp**, sl2 wyif. [dec 1 st]

Repeat rows 3 and 4, 0 (1, 3, 4, 4, 6) more times. There are 47 (52, 54, 59, 67, 69) sts in front.

Work the armhole and neckline decreases every 2 rows:

Row 1 (RS): k1, ssk, yo, **ssk**, work in embroidery stitch to 5 sts from end, **k2tog**, yo, k2tog, k1. [dec 2 sts]

Row 2 (WS): sl2 wyif, p to 2 sts from end, sl2 wyif.

Repeat rows 1 and 2, 5 (8, 9, 12, 16, 17) more times. There are 35 (34, 34, 33, 33, 33) sts in front.

Work the neckline decreases:

Row 1 (RS): k1, ssk, yo, work in embroidery stitch to 5 sts from end, **k2tog**, yo, k2tog, k1. [dec 1 st]

Row 2 (WS): sl2 wyif, p to 2 sts from end, sl2 wyif.

Repeat rows 1 and 2, 20 (19, 17, 16, 14, 14) more times. There are 14 (14, 16, 16, 18, 18) sts in front.

Work 4 (4, 6, 6, 6, 6) more rows in stockinette stitch. The front should measure approx. 16 (17, 18, 20, 21, 22) cm from the armhole. Leave all sts on hold.

RIGHT FRONT

Place the 51 (59, 67, 75, 83, 91) sts on hold for the right front on the needles and work as follows:

Row 1 (RS): k1, ssk, yo, work 45 (53, 61, 69, 77, 85) sts in embroidery stitch (as established), yo, k2tog, k1.

Work the armhole and neckline decreases on every row:

Row 2 (WS): sl2 wyif, **p2tog**, p to 2 sts from end, sl2 wyif. [dec 1 st]

Row 3 (RS): k1, ssk, yo, **ssk**, work in embroidery stitch to 5 sts from end, **k2tog**, yo, k2tog, k1. [dec 2 sts]

Row 4: sl2 wyif, **p2tog**, p to 2 sts from end, sl2 wyif. [dec 1 st]

Repeat rows 3 and 4, 0 (1, 3, 4, 4, 6) more times. There are 47 (52, 54, 59, 67, 69) sts in front.

Work the armhole and neckline decreases every 2 rows:

Row 1 (RS): k1, ssk, yo, **ssk**, work in embroidery stitch to 5 sts from end, **k2tog**, yo, k2tog, k1. [dec 2 sts]

Row 2 (WS): sl2 wyif, p to 2 sts from end, sl2 wyif.

Repeat rows 1 and 2, 5 (8, 9, 12, 16, 14) more times. There are 35 (34, 34, 33, 33, 33) sts in front.

Work the neckline decreases:

Row 1 (RS): k1, ssk, yo, **ssk**, work in embroidery stitch to 3 sts from end, yo, k2tog, k1. [dec 1 st]

Row 2 (WS): sl2 wyif, p to 2 sts from end, sl2 wyif.

Repeat rows 1 and 2, 20 (19, 17, 16, 14, 14) more times. There are 14 (14, 16, 16, 18, 18) sts in front. Work 4 (4, 6, 6, 6, 6) more rows in stockinette stitch. Front should measure approx. 16 (17, 18, 20, 21, 22) cm from the armhole. Leave all sts on hold.

RIGHT SIDE OF THE BACK

Separate the back: k1, ssk, yo, knit 45 (53, 61, 69, 77, 85) sts in embroidery stitch (as established), yo, k2tog, k1; slip the next 51 (59, 67, 75, 83, 91) sts into waste yarn and leave on hold for the left back. Knit following the same instructions

as for the left front. Join the right shoulder with a 3-needle bind-off: place the next 14 (14, 16, 16, 18, 18) sts from the right front on an extra needle; place the 2 needles (back and front) in parallel in the left hand and, from the WS, bind off the back stitches with the matching front stitches.

LEFT SIDE OF THE BACK

Place the sts on hold for the left side on the needles and work following the same instructions as for the right front. Join the left shoulder with a 3-needle row: place the 14 (14, 16, 16, 18, 18) sts from the left front on an extra needle; place the 2 needles (back and front) in parallel in the left hand and, from the WS, bind off the back stitches with the matching front stitches.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends with a tapestry needle. Wash carefully with mild soap. Block garment to final measurements.

ABBREVIATIONS

k knit

p purl

cm centimeters

Rep repeat

approx. approximately

RS right side

WS wrong side

st/sts stitch/stitches

rnd/rnds round/rounds

pm place marker

slm slip marker

BOR beginning of round marker

sl1wyif slip 1 st purlwise and with the yarn in front of the work.

sl2wyif slip 2 sts purlwise and with the yarn in front of the work.

yo yarn over

k2tog knit 2 stitches together

P2tog purl 2 stitches together

ssk slip, slip, knit (slip a stitch as if to knit, slip a second stitch as if to knit, insert left needle into the front of the slipped stitches and knit).

ssp slip, slip, purl (slip a stitch as if to knit, slip a second stitch as if to knit, slip the two slipped sts back to the left-hand needle and purl them together through the back loops).

Stockinette stitch knit all right side rows and purl all wrong side rows (in the round: knit all rounds).

Flower insert the right needle into the space between the decreases (k2tog and ssk) worked previously and pull through one loop, leave the loop on the right-hand needle and knit 2 sts, pull through a second loop in the same way and in the same stitch. Leave the loops loose so they don't pull the fabric.
