



# AMIEIRA

**#TRICOTAMOSJUNTOSDEOUTONO2024**

**#AMIEIRAVEST**

With the support of:

*Rosários4*<sup>®</sup>

**YARN:** 6 (7, 8) balls of BELMONTE from Rosários4, color 37 (50% organic wool, 50% organic cotton; 50 gr = 125 m).

**GAUGE:** 24 sts and 30 rows – 10 x 10 cm in stockinette stitch with 3.5 mm needle, sample washed and dried (it's important to wash and block your swatch in order to get the correct gauge).

**NEEDLES:** 3 mm and 3.5 mm circular needles (if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).

**NOTIONS:** tapestry needle, stitch markers, waste yarn.

**SIZES:** 1, 2, 3.

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:** 50 (56, 60) cm wide in front and back.

# PART 1

## BACK

With smaller needles, long-tail cast on 127 (143, 151) sts. Work in 1x1 rib, as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** k2, (p1, k1) x 6, p1, **pm**, (k1, p1) rep to 16 sts from end, k1, **pm**, p1, (k1, p1) x 6, k2.

**Row 2 (WS):** sl2 wyif, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, k1, sl2 wyif (slide the markers when you reach them).

**Row 3:** k2, (p1, k1) rep to 3 sts from end, p1, k2 (slide the markers when you reach them).

**Row 4:** rep row 2.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 another 4 times.

Change to bigger needles and work in stockinette stitch with ribbed side panels:

**Row 1:** k2, (p1, k1) x 6, p1, slm, k to marker, slm, p1, (k1, p1) x 6, k2.

**Row 2:** sl2 wyif, (k1, sl1 wyif) x 6, k1, slm, p to marker, slm, k1, (sl1 wyif, k1) x 6, sl2 wyif.

Continue working in established pattern until you complete a total of 144 (156, 168) rows from the end of rib. The piece should measure approx. 49 (52.5, 56) cm from the beginning. Leave all the stitches on hold.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**k:** knit

**p:** purl

**cm:** centimeters

**rep:** repeat

**approx.:** approximately

**RS:** right side

**WS:** wrong side

**st/sts:** stitch/ stitches

**pm:** place marker

**slm:** slip marker

**sl1 wyif:** slip 1 st purlwise with the yarn in front of the work.

**sl2 wyif:** slip 2 sts purlwise with the yarn in front of the work.

# PART 2

## FRONT

With smaller needles, long-tail cast on 127 (143, 151) sts. Work in 1x1 rib, as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** k2, (p1, k1) x 6, p1, **pm**, (k1, p1) rep to 16 sts from end, k1, **pm**, p1, (k1, p1) x 6, k2.

**Row 2 (WS):** sl2 wyif, (k1, p1) rep to 3 sts from end, k1, sl2 wyif (slide the markers when you reach them).

**Row 3:** k2, (p1, k1) rep to 3 sts from end, p1, k2 (slide the markers when you reach them).

**Row 4:** rep row 2.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 another 4 times.

Change to bigger needles and work in woven stitch with ribbed side panels, as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** k2, (p1, k1) x 6, p1, slm, (k1, yo, cdd, yo) rep to 1 st before marker, k1, slm, p1, (k1, p1) x 6, k2.

**Row 2 (WS):** sl2 wyif, (k1, sl1 wyif) x 6, k1, slm, k2, (p1, 3M) rep to 3 sts before marker, p1, k2, slm, k1, (sl1 wyif, k1) x 6, sl2 wyif.

**Row 3:** k2, (p1, k1) x 6, p1, slm, p2, k1, (3L, k1) rep to 2 sts before marker, p2, slm, p1, (k1, p1) x 6, k2.

**Row 4:** rep row 2.

**Row 5:** rep row 3.

**Row 6:** rep row 2.

**Row 7:** k2, (p1, k1) x 6, p1, slm, k2tog, yo, k1, (yo, cdd, yo, k1) rep to 2 sts before marker, yo, skp, slm, p1, (k1, p1) x 6, k2.

**Row 8:** sl2 wyif, (k1, sl1 wyif) x 6, k1, slm, (p1, 3M) rep até 1 m antes do marc, p1, slm, k1, (sl1 wyif, k1) x 6, sl2 wyif.

**Row 9:** k2, (p1, k1) x 6, p1, slm, (k1, 3L) rep até 1 m antes do marc, k1, slm, p1, (k1, p1) x 6, k2.

**Row 10:** rep a Row 8.

**Row 11:** rep a Row 9.

**Row 12:** rep a Row 8.

Repeat rows 1 to 12, 8 (9, 10) more times. Next, work rows 1 to 10, one more time.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**yo:** yarn over.

**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together.

**skp:** slip 1, knit 1, pass slipped stitch over (slip a stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, with left hand needle pass slipped stitch over).

**cdd:** centered double decrease (slip 2 stitches together as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, with left hand needle pass slipped stitch over)
