Rosários 4

YARN

- 1 skein of **Re-Wool** from Rosários 4, **color 03- color A**;
- 2 skein of **Re-Wool** from Rosários 4, **color 07- color B**;
- 2 skein of **Re-Wool** from Rosários 4, **color 05- color C**;
- 3 skein of **Re-Wool** from Rosários 4, **color 02- color D**;
- 2 skeins of **Re-Wool** da Rosários 4, **color 09 - color E**.

GAUGE

18 sts and 26 rnds – 10 x 10 cm in stockinette stitch with 4 mm needles, using 3 mm needles, washed and blocked (it is important to wash and dry the swatch as stitch count may change after the first wash)

NEEDLES

3.5 and 4 mm circular needles (adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge).

NOTIONS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, scrap yarn.

SIZE

5.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

152 chest circumference (see final measurements in the schematic); these measurements include approx. 35 a 40 cm of positive ease at the bust.

This cardigan is worked in 2 pieces. Begin by knitting 2 hexagons, from the center outwards and in the round. The beginning of the hexagons is worked using the magic loop method, but you can use 5 double-pointed needles if you prefer. Then, join the 2 hexagons by grafting the marked areas to form the body of the cardigan. The remaining length of the sleeves is worked in the round, from the end of one side of the hexagon down to the cuff. Finally, knit the waistband and the front bands from the stitches held on the sides of the hexagons.



HEXAGON

With color A, cast on 6 sts using a magic ring. Work in the round.

Rnd 1: kfb x 6. [12 sts]

Rnd 2 and all even rnds: knit.

Rnd 3: (k1, yo) rep to end. [24 sts]

Rnd 5: (k2, yo, k1, yo, k1, pm) x 5, k2, yo, k1, yo, k1. [36 sts]

Rnd 7: (k3, yo, k1, yo, k2, sm) x 6. [48 sts]

Rnd 9: (k1, yo, knit to marker, yo, sm) x 6. [inc 12 sts]

Rnd 11: (k2, yo, knit to 1 st before marker, yo, k1, sm) x 6. [inc 12 sts]

Rnd 13: (k3, yo, knit to 2 sts before marker, yo, k2, sm) x 6. [inc 12 sts]

Repeat rnds 9–14 a further 11 times. Repeat rnds 9–12 once more. At the end of the hexagon, you should have completed a total of 84 rnds. There will be 84 sts between markers. Cut yarn, leaving approx. 160 cm of tail for grafting the sleeve. The hexagon should measure approx. 32 cm in height and 47 cm along each side.

COLOR CHANGES

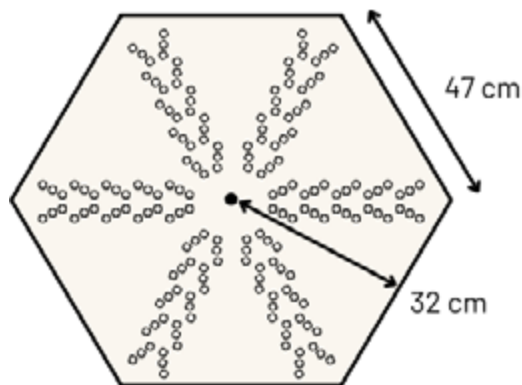
On round 25 change to **color B**;

on round 45 change to **color C**;

on round 65 change to **color D**.

In other words, change color every 20, rounds.

Note: If you prefer to make the hexagon using only 3 colors, make the first color change after 28 rounds, and then change color every 28 rounds.



Fold the hexagon as follows:

1. Slip the next 85 sts (up to 1 st after the first marker) onto a scrap yarn and leave on hold for the sleeve.
2. Join the tips of the circular needle and, using a tapestry needle and the yarn tail, graft 83 sts (up to the 2nd marker on the front needle and up to 1 st before the fifth marker on the back needle).
3. Slip the next 84 sts onto a scrap yarn and leave on hold for the back (up to the 3rd marker).
4. Slip the next 85 sts onto another scrap yarn and leave on hold for the waistband (up to 1 st after the 4th marker).
5. Slip the remaining 84 sts onto another scrap yarn and leave on hold for the front.

Repeat the entire instructions for the second hexagon. Fold the second hexagon as follows:

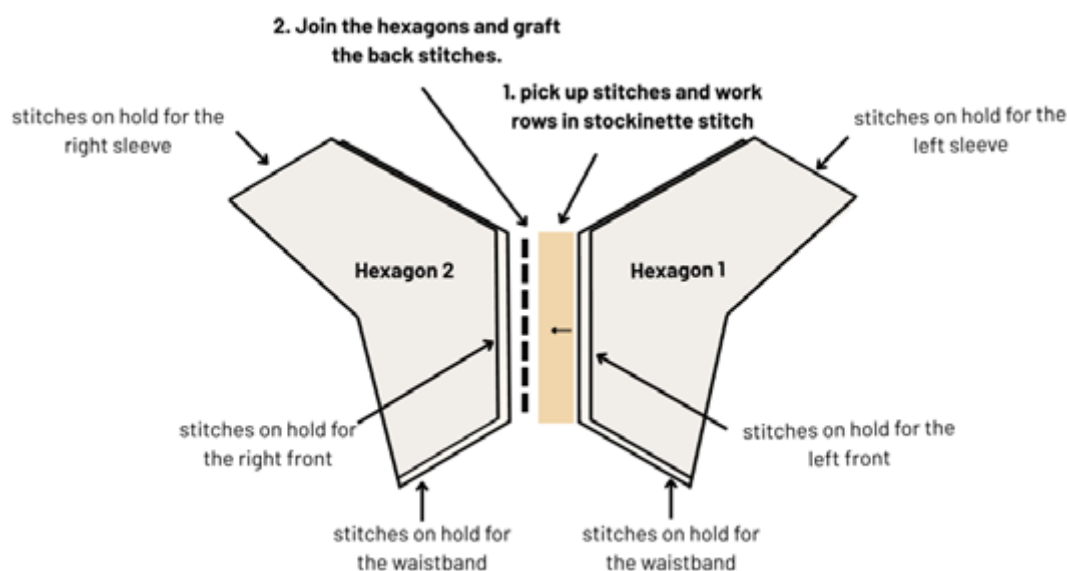
1. Slip the next 85 sts (up to 1 st after the 1st marker) onto a scrap yarn and hold for the sleeve.
2. Join the tips of the circular needle and, using a tapestry needle and the yarn tail left earlier, graft 83 sts (up to the 2nd marker on the front needle and up to 1 st before the 5th marker on the back needle).

3. Slip the next 84 sts onto a scrap yarn and hold for the front (up to the 3rd marker).
4. Slip the next 85 sts onto another scrap yarn and hold for the waistband (up to 1 st after the 4th marker).
5. Slip the remaining 84 sts onto another scrap yarn and hold for the back.

BACK

Place the stitches held for the back of the 1st hexagon on the needle. With RS facing, join Color D and work 14 rows in stockinette stitch. Cut the yarn, leaving approx. 160 cm of tail for grafting.

Joining the Back: Place the stitches held for the back of the second hexagon on the needle and, using the yarn tail left earlier and a tapestry needle, graft the 84 sts, joining the 2 hexagons.



SLEEVES

Place the 85 sts held for the sleeve on the larger needle. Join Color D and knit all sts; pick up and knit 3 sts along the shoulder edge (where the sts were grafted). There will be 88 sts on the needle. Join to work in the round, knit 44 sts, and place a marker at the underarm.

Cut Color D, join Color E, and knit 26 rounds in stockinette stitch. The sleeve should measure approx. 42 cm from the underarm, or 4 cm less than the desired final length.

Switch to the smaller needle and work the decreases as follows: (k2tog) rep to end. There will be 44 sts. Work in 1x1 rib as follows: (k1, p1) rep to end. Repeat this round 14 more times. Bind off all sts in pattern.

WAISTBAND

Place the 85 sts held for the waistband on the left side of the cardigan on the smaller needle. Join Color E and knit all sts; pick up and knit 13 sts along the back edge. Place the 85 sts held for the waistband on the right side of the cardigan on the left needle and knit in stockinette stitch. There will be 183 sts on the needle.

Work in 1x1 rib as follows:

Row 1 (RS): k2, (k1, p1) rep to 1 st before end, k1.

Row 2 (WS): p2, (p1, k1) rep to 1 st before end, p1.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 6 more times. Repeat Row 1 once more. Bind off all sts in pattern.

FRONT BANDS

With RS facing, using Color E and the smaller needle, pick up and knit 11 sts along the side of the right front waistband. Place the 84 sts held on the right front on the left needle and knit in stockinette stitch. Pick up and knit 13 sts along the back edge. Place the 84 sts held on the left front on the left needle and knit in stockinette stitch. Pick up and knit 11 sts along the side of the waistband. There will be 203 sts on the needle.

Work in 1x1 rib as follows:

Row 1 (RS): k2, (k1, p1) rep to 1 st before end, k1.

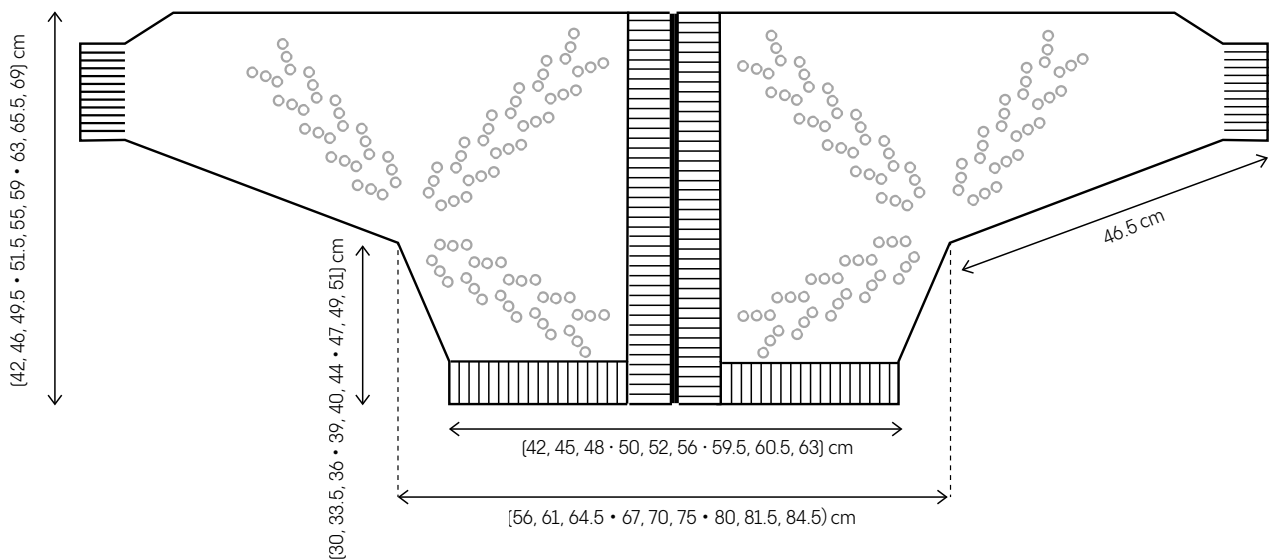
Row 2 (WS): p2, (p1, k1) rep to 1 st before end, p1.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 6 more times. Repeat Row 1 once more. Bind off all sts in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in all yarn ends using a tapestry needle. Gently wash the piece with a mild detergent. Block the piece, adjusting it to the final measurements.

MEASUREMENT SCHEME



ABBREVIATIONS

k	knit
p	purl
cm	centimeters
approx	approximately
st/sts	stitch/stitches
rnd/rnds	round/ rounds
rep	repeat
RS	right side
WS	wrong side
pm	place marker
slm	slip marker
BOR	beginning of round marker
inc	increases
yo	yarn over
Kfb	knit front and back (knit 1 stitch but don't drop it off left-hand needle; knit the same stitch again through back loop and drop it off the needle)
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
Stockinette stitch	knit all right side rows and purl all wrong side rows (in the round: knit all rounds)
