YARN

2 balls of **Balada** from Rosários 4, color 35 (1 ball for the cowl and 1 ball for the mittens).

GAUGE

24 sts (2 repeats of chart A) = 10 cm in lace pattern, worked with 3 mm needles, washed and blocked.

(It is important to wash and dry the swatch, as stitch count may change after the first wash)

NEEDLES

3 mm circular needles with a 60 cm cable for the neckline. 2.5 mm circular needles with a 80 cm cable for the gloves; if you prefer to avoid the magic loop method for the gloves, you will need 5 double-pointed needles in the same size. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge.

NOTIONS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, waste yarn.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Cowl with 55 cm circumference and 20 cm height; mittens with 20 cm circumference and 17 cm height.



COWL

With 3 mm needles, cast on 132 sts using a long-tail cast-on. Join to work in the round, taking care not to twist the cast-on edge, place the BOR marker, and work in Garter Stitch:

Rnd 1: p to end.

Rnd 2: k to end.

Work in lace pattern, following Chart A or the written instructions below:

Rnd 1: (k3, p7, k2) repeat to end.

Rnd 2 and all even rnds: k to end.

Rnd 3: k1, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo.

Rnd 5: k2, yo, k2, p1, p3tog, p1, k2, yo, k1.

Rnd 7: k3, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2.

Repeat rnds 1 to 8 6 more times, completing 7 repeats of the chart.

Purl 1 rnd.

Bind off all sts knitwise.

GLOVES

With 2.5 mm needles, cast on 48 sts using a long-tail cast-on. Join to work in the round, taking care not to twist the cast-on edge, place the BOR marker, and work in Garter Stitch:

Rnd 1: p to end.

Rnd 2: k to end.

Work in lace pattern, following Chart A or the written instructions below:

Rnd 1: (k3, p7, k2) rep to end.

Rnd 2 and all even rnds: k to end.

Rnd 3: (k1, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo) rep to end.

Rnd 5: (k2, yo, k2, p1, p3tog, p1, k2, yo, k1) rep to end.

Rnd 7: (k3, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2) rep to end.

Repeat Rnds 1 to 8 1 more time, completing 2 repeats of the chart.

Work the thumb increases:

Rnd 1: M1R, k1, M1L, **pm**, k2, p7, k2, (k3, p7, k2) × 3

Rnd 2 and all even rnds: k to end.

Rnd 3: M1R, k3, M1L, slm, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo, (k1, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo) × 3.

Rnd 5: M1R, k5, M1L, slm, k1, yo, k2, p1, p3tog, p1, k2, yo, k1, (k2, yo, k2, p1, p3tog, p1, k2, yo, k1) × 3.

Rnd 7: M1R, k7, M1L, slm, k2, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2, (k3, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2) × 3.

Rnd 9: M1R, k9, M1L, slm, k2, p7, k2, (k3, p7, k2) × 3.

Rnd 11: M1R, k11, M1L, slm, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo, (k1, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo) × 3.

Rnd 13: M1R, k13, M1L, slm, k1, yo, k2, p1, p3tog, p1, k2, yo, k1, (k2, yo, k2, p1, p3tog, p1, k2, yo, k1) × 3.

Rnd 15: M1R, k15, M1L, slm, k2, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2, (k3, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2) × 3.

Rnd 17: M1R, k17, M1L, slm, k2, p7, k2, (k3, p7, k2) × 3.

Rnd 19: Slip the 19 thumb sts onto a scrap yarn and leave them on hold, remove marker, cast on 1 st using backward loop cast-on, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo, (k1, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo) × 3.

Rnd 21: (k2, yo, k2, p1, p3tog, p1, k2, yo, k1) × 4.

Rnd 23: (k3, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2) rep to end.

Rnd 25: (k3, p7, k2) rep to end.

Rnd 27: (k1, yo, k2, p2, p3tog, p2, k2, yo) rep to end.

Rnd 29: (k2, yo, k2, p1, p3tog, p1, k2, yo, k1) rep to end.

Rnd 31: (k3, yo, k2, p3tog, k2, yo, k2) rep to end.

Do not forget to knit rnd 32! Purl 1 rnd. Bind off all sts knitwise.

THUMB

Slip the 19 sts held on scrap yarn back onto the needles and knit, pick up and knit 1 st over the cast-on st. You will have 20 sts.

Knit 6 rnds.

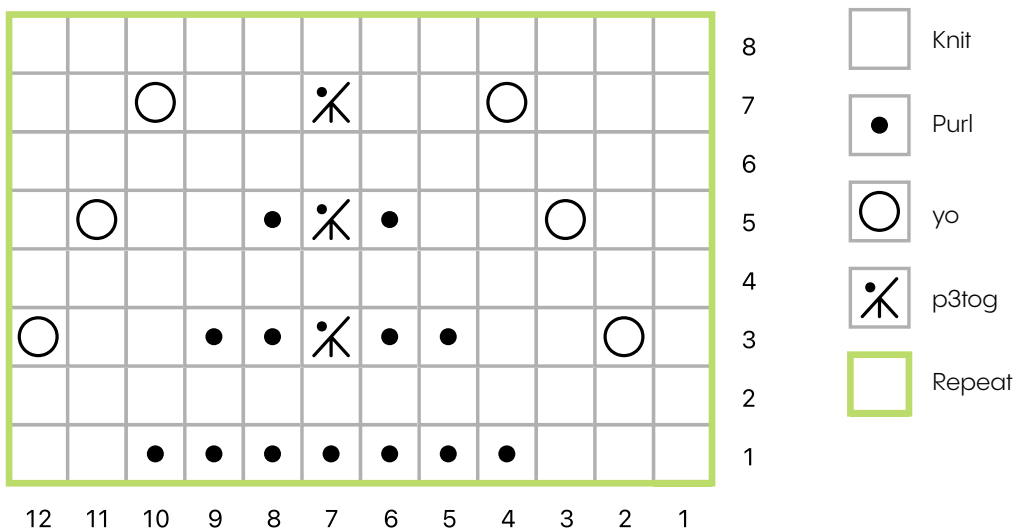
Purl 1 rnd.

Bind off all sts knitwise.

FINISHING

Weave in all yarn ends using a tapestry needle. Gently wash the piece with a mild detergent. Block the piece, adjusting it to the final measurements.

CHART A



ABBREVIATIONS

K	knit
P	purl
cm	centimeters
rep	repeat
RS	right side
WS	wrong side
st/sts	stitch/ stitches
rnd/ rnds	round/ rounds
pm	place marker
slm	slip marker
BOR	beginning of round marker
yo	yarn over
p3tog	purl 3 stitches together
M1L	make one left (insert the left-hand needle from front to back under the strand of yarn that runs between the stitch just worked and the next stitch on the left-hand needle; knit this st through the back loop)
M1R	make one right (insert the left-hand needle from back to front under the strand of yarn that runs between the stitch just worked and the next stitch on the left-hand needle; knit this st through the front loop)
