For: *Rosários4*®

YARN: 2 skeins of Alfama in color 49 - color A;
4 skeins of Marvila in color 116 - color B;
3 skeins of Alfama in color 21 - color C;
3 skeins of Alfama in color 37 - color D.

GAUGE: 21 sts and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm [4 x 4"] in stockinette stitch with 3 mm needles, washed and blocked. It is important to wash and block your swatch as the stitch count may change after the first wash. While gauge is not crucial for this project, differences in gauge may affect the final measurements and the amount of yarn required.

NEEDLES: 3 mm [US 2.5] circular needles with 80 or 100 cm [32 or 40"] cable. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

PART 4

Cut color D and, with color B, work in stockinette stitch as follows:

Row 1 (RS): k1, skp, knit to 2 sts from end, yo, k2tog. [1 st dec]

Row 2 (WS): sl1wyif, purl to 2 sts from end, sl2wyif.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 another 28 times. [6 sts remain on the needle]

Row 59: k1, skp, k1, yo, k2tog. [5 sts]

Row 60: sl1wyif, p2, sl2wyif.

Row 61: k1, skp, yo, k2tog. [4 sts]

Row 62: sl1wyif, p1, sl2wyif.

Bind off all stitches knitwise.

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
